

Roy-Hart Youth Baseball/Softball Protest Form

All protests must be declared to the umpire and opposing coach at the time of the incident. Only violations of rules may be protested, i.e. pitcher pitching too many innings in a week, ineligible player on roster, etc. An umpire's call on individual plays will not be overruled, as the umpire's decision is final.

In order for a protest to be accepted it must be received in writing by the division representative within 24 hours of the protested games scheduled start time. If submitting a written protest within the 24 hour period is not possible, the protesting coach must call the division representative, or any other board member, and make arrangements for a written protest to be submitted within 48 hours of the phone call. The protest must include the rule that was violated.
